SPECIAL SESSION MINUTES
January 13, 2016

REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

CALL TO ORDER: The City Council of Lisbon, Iowa, met in special session in the City Council Chambers on January 13, 2016, at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Beryl O'Connor presiding. The following City Council members were present: John Bardsley, Travis Jubeck, Joe Nelson, Doug O'Connor and Nate Smith. Absent: None.

Citizen's present: Bob Wolfe, Betty Stoneking, Amy White, Joe Long and Ricky Scott.

AGENDA: Motion by Nelson, seconded by Smith to approve the agenda. All Ayes. Motion carried 5-0.

Bob Wolfe presented the budget request for Southeast Linn Community Center. The request was the same as the previous year with the addition of \$4,000 for the after school program. This money was previously budgeted in the library's budget and transferred to SE Linn. It was decided to include it in SE Linn's budget since that is where the funds are used. Meier also discussed the need to do improvements on the SE Linn building and that repairs such as leaking windows and some cosmetic repairs are necessary. Nelson asked Meier to do another inspection of the building to find out exactly what needs to be done.

Amy White and Sara Ellison presented the budget request for the library. Most line items remained the same except for a three percent increase for salaries and deleting the \$4,000 for after school program which was transferred to SE Linn. They had asked that the repairs needing to be done in the basement be reconsidered and placed in the capital projects plan.

Fire Chief Joe Long presented the budget request for the fire department. While most line items stayed the same, Long asked for additional money in the budget to allow for physicals for the firemen.

Police Chief Ricky Scott presented the budget request for the police department. Increases included a line item for food and supplies for the K9, upgrading of cameras and the possibility of dispatch fees to Linn County.

City Administrator, Connie Meier, updated the council on an estimate from the city engineer to add a wall around the sewer plant to prevent future flooding. She also discussed the current contract with KMVL and their request for upgraded equipment. The council decided that they would like to look at other options that may be available to be able to broadcast the council meetings. Discussion was held on the next regular council meeting being on the same night as the wrestling dual with Don Bosco. Due to council members wanting to attend the meet, the time for the next regular council meeting was set for 6:30 p.m.

ADJOURN: Mayor O'Connor adjourned the meeting at 8:45 p.m.
