Call Before You Water

For all new construction and new sod properties, the City of Lisbon allows for an adjustment on your bill if you call prior to watering. You will be given 30 days to water as much as needed after which time the adjustment will no longer be calculated and you will be responsible for all charges on your monthly bill. ***This does not apply to watering of gardens, power washing or other excessive water usage.*** Questions please call City Hall at 455-2459.

City of Lisbon Cemetery Notice:

To facilitate clean-up at the Lisbon and St. John's Cemeteries, please remove ALL arrangements you wish to save before October 1st, 2016. Arrangements include all artificial and fresh arrangements on any portion of the lot, slab or monument. This includes flowers in vases attached to the monument and flowers on cradles atop the monument. New arrangements can be placed after October 15th, 2016.


