(Tickets will only be sold in advance at the Lisbon City Hall and NOT on the day of the event.)

LARGE ITEM DROP OFF LOCATED AT THE CITY SHOP
Vehicles should approach area going east on Market to dead end.

Restrictions: NO TIRES WILL BE ACCEPTED, appliances limited to two per household or business. Tanning beds go to the city shop with the bulbs removed. The city and the waste hauler reserves the right to deny articles deemed unacceptable.

ELECTRONICS/HAZARDOUS WASTE DROP-OFF AT THE SCHOOL NORTH PARKING LOT.

Vehicles should enter from South Street and exit onto S Jefferson
Electronic Restrictions: Businesses limited to two items.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

Radioactive materials, untreated medical waste, deposit beverage containers, any recyclable materials, pressurized tanks, any material usually deposited in garbage bags, construction materials (shingles, concrete, re-rod, etc.) antifreeze, burn barrels and ash, and large commercial appliances (walk-in freezers, commercial stoves, etc.)
