SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
February 5, 2020

CALL TO ORDER: The City Council of Lisbon, Iowa, met in special session in the City Council Chambers on February 5th, 2020, at 7:15 p.m. with Mayor Pro-tem Nate Smith presiding. The following City Council members were present: John Bardsley, Stephanie Kamberling, Travis Jubeck and Sara Nost. Absent: Mayor Doug O'Connor.

Pledge of Allegiance.

CONSENT AGENDA: Kamberling motioned, seconded by Jubeck to approve the Consent Agenda, consisting of the Agenda. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Brandon Siggins presented the budget requests for Emergency Management and the Lisbon Fire Department. He noted that the current cardiac monitor would no longer be supported at the end of 2020 and they need to look into purchasing a new one. The cost would be around \$30,000. He felt that the Association may be able to help with the cost but asked the council to begin budgeting for the purchase.

Rick Scott presented the Police Department budget request asking for increases to purchase new bullet proof vests and a new software program.

Travis Bagby presented the budget request for water, sewer and road use, requesting the purchase of a new pickup truck. He noted that the current vehicle would be able to last a few more years if it was used part-time around town only and suggested it be given to the Park and Recreation Department.

Meier went over the budget request for solid waste and the general fund noting no significant increase except for an increase in engineering expenses to begin the process of Phase I on the sports complex and moving forward with the nature park.

ADJOURN: Mayor Pro-tem Smith adjourned the special meeting at 8:45 p.m.
