Leaf Vacuuming will take place on the 2nd & 4th Monday in the months of October and November starting October 12th. The city crews will be performing the work so please have patience. **Please pile leaves behind the curb and NOT in the street.**

Brush pickup will be the **1st MONDAY** of every month. Small sticks, twigs and branches need to be placed in neat piles on the curb to be chipped. This is performed by Lisbon Public Works Dept.

Yard Waste pickup will be the **2nd MONDAY** of every month. Garden debris needs to be placed in a rigid container or a yard waste bag for easy pick up. This is performed by Johnson County Refuse.

Lisbon Public Works Department will be exercising valves and flushing hydrants during the month of October (*may start late September*). This may cause temporary low water pressure and discoloration. The City apologizes for any inconveniences. All dates are subject to weather and time permitting.

Cemetery Cleaning Notice: To facilitate clean-up at the Lisbon and St. John's Cemeteries, please remove ALL arrangements you wish to save before October 1st. Arrangements include all artificial and fresh arrangements on any portion of the lot, slab or monument. This includes flowers in vases attached to the monument and flowers on cradles atop the monument. New arrangements can be placed after October 15th.

The Lisbon Police Department would like to remind drivers to watch out for kids before and after school. This includes students walking, biking, driving and scooters. Thank you.
