

**ORDINANCE NO. 01-2022**

An Ordinance Amending the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lisbon, Iowa, by Amending Provisions Pertaining to History Center and History Center Foundation

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the City of Lisbon, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Chapter 28, Section 3, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lisbon, Iowa, is hereby repealed and the following is adopted in lieu thereof:

**28.03 HISTORY CENTER FOUNDATION BOARD ESTABLISHED.**

1. The number of Directors for the History Center Foundation shall be no fewer than 5 and no greater than 15. Each Director shall hold office for one year.

SECTION 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

On the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January 2022 at a regular meeting of the Lisbon City Council, Lisbon, Iowa, Councilperson Smith introduced Ordinance No. 01-2022 and moved that it be given its first reading. The motion was seconded by Councilperson Bardsley.

Ayes: Smith, Bardsley, Scott and Nost. Nays: None Absent: Williams

Four (4) members of the council being present and having voted "Aye", Mayor Doug O'Connor declared the motion carried, and Ordinance No. 01-2022, was read the first time and discussed and placed on record.

Motion by Bardsley, seconded by Scott to suspend the rules and place the ordinance on the third and final reading. Ayes: Smith, Bardsley, Scott and Nost. Nays: None Absent: Williams Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Nost to approve the third and final reading of Ordinance No. 01-2022. Ayes: Smith, Bardsley, Scott and Nost. Nays: None Absent: Williams

Four (4) members of the council being present and having voted "Aye", Mayor Doug O'Connor declared the motion carried, and Ordinance No 01-2022, was passed and adopted.
