REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
March 9, 2020

CALL TO ORDER: The City Council of Lisbon, Iowa, met in regular session in the City Council Chambers on March 9th, 2020, at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Doug O'Connor presiding. The following City Council members were present: John Bardsley, Travis Jubeck, Stephanie Kamberling, Sara Nost and Nate Smith. Absent: None.

CONSENT AGENDA: Kamberling motioned, seconded by Smith to approve the Consent Agenda, consisting of the Agenda, Minutes of February 24, 2020, February 2020 Treasurer's Report, Utility Deposit Refund and Approval of Warrants. All Ayes. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Kamberling, seconded by Nost to approve the final payment request for housing rehabilitation project in the amount of \$25,087. All Ayes. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Kamberling to open the public hearing at 7:02 regarding the FY21 Budget. All Ayes. Motion carried 5-0. No public input was received. Motion by Kamberling, seconded by Nost to close the public hearing at 7:03. All Ayes. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Kamberling, seconded by Nost to approve Resolution 09-2020 Approving the FY21 Budget. Roll Call: Ayes: Bardsley, Jubeck, Kamberling, Nost, Smith. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Bardsley, seconded by Smith to approve Resolution 08-2020 Approving Agreement with Pioneer Township for Fire Protection. Roll Call: Ayes: Bardsley, Jubeck, Kamberling, Nost, Smith. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Kamberling, seconded by Bardsley to approve Resolution 10-2020 Certifying a Lien against Property for Snow Removal. Roll Call: Ayes: Bardsley, Jubeck, Kamberling, Nost, Smith. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Kamberling, seconded by Smith to approve Resolution 11-2020 Certifying Liens against Landlords for Nonpayment of Rental Inspection Fees. Roll Call: Ayes: Bardsley, Jubeck, Kamberling, Nost, Smith. Nays: None. Absent: None. Motion carried 5-0.

Discussion was held on possible changes to the Parking Ordinance to allow overnight parking on the downtown blocks during the year and only having no parking during the winter months. Bagby also asked for changes to clarify the code on parking near a hydrant. Scott asked about allowing parking on the west end of South Street between Jefferson and Chestnut. Council was not in favor of this but asked Meier to place it on the agenda for the next joint council meeting with the School Board.

Motion by Bardsley, seconded by Nost to set a public hearing for April 13, 2020 for changes to the City Code of Ordinance Chapter 69. All Ayes. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion by Bardsley, seconded by Jubeck to set a public hearing regarding a copier lease for March 23, 2020. All Ayes. Motion carried 5-0.

The City's current sick leave policy was discussed. No action was taken.

Meier reported for the city engineer that he is meeting with the DOT on March 10th to further discuss repairs needed to Business 30. He is still working on gathering information for an IUP for the water project and a possible grant through CDBG.

Bagby reported that they are still trimming and doing brush pickup. He will have the street sweeper out at the end of the week when the weather clears. Meier reminded people that once the city goes through their neighborhood on brush pickup day, they will not be back through until the next scheduled pick up.

Scott reminded everyone to make sure your golf carts are registered and that those driving mopeds must have a moped license.

Chief Siggins reminded everyone of the Fireman's Dance on Saturday, March 14th.

Jubeck asked about Mechanicsville Telephone and how far they are on installing lines throughout the City.

Bardsley reminded everyone of the Trivia contest on March 21st sponsored by Friends of the Library.

Kamberling thanked the O'Connor family for their service to the community and dedication to the City.
