**REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**  
**October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

**CALL TO ORDER:** The City Council of Lisbon, Iowa, met in regular session on October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 7:00p.m. with Mayor Doug O'Connor presiding. The following City Council members were present: John Bardsley, Rick Scott, Kevin Steele and Nathan Smith.

**CONSENT AGENDA:** Motion by Bardsley, seconded by Smith to approve the consent agenda consisting of minutes of October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2025, list of bills and liquor license for Whitey's Bar & Grill, LLC. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Bardsley to accept receipt of a petition to establish an Emergency Medical Services District under Iowa 357G. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Scott, seconded by Smith to add stop signs to Kraiburg Boulevard and Meyers Drive. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Bardsley to set a public hearing to establish an Emergency Medical Services District for November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Bardsley, seconded by Steele to set a public hearing and bid date for Chemical Feed Building and Well No. 5 rebid for November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Scott, seconded by Smith to approve Resolution 35-2025 to Appoint Rawley Alger to Council. Roll call vote. Ayes: Bardsley, Steele, Smith, and Scott. Absent: None. Nays: None. Motion carried 4-0.

The council received the following reports from city departments:

Public Works Director Travis Bagby – pipe issues at a well fixed, well 5 work continues, bases for dugouts at sports complex, manhole at grant avenue, concrete work by Gillette all pending weather.

Parks & Recreation Director Drayton Kamberling – girls basketball started and a camp. Halloweentown events will be Friday October 31<sup>st</sup> from 5-7pm downtown.

Ambulance Director Jacob Lindauer – busy quarter, preparing for inspection in spring and end of year items.

City Administrator Brandon Siggins – fire department is hose testing. Library is open after shelves are installed, park restrooms closed for season, Elite stone project moving along, sports complex moving along as well, new budget preparation, insurance meeting on Wednesday, and last yard waste pick up for the year will be November 10<sup>th</sup>.

Council member Bardsley thanked the public works crew for all their hard work at the library, congratulated City Clerk Christina Eicher on a magazine article she wrote and reminded citizens to get out and vote next week.
