REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
October 28th, 2024

CALL TO ORDER: The City Council of Lisbon, Iowa, met in regular session on October 28th, 2024, at 7:00p.m. with Mayor Doug O'Connor presiding. The following City Council members were present: John Bardsley, Kevin Steele, Nathan Smith and Mike Williams. Rick Scott was absent.

OTHERS PRESENT: Brandon Siggins, Travis Bagby, and Drayton Kamberling. Maggie Burger and Dave Schechinger were present via zoom.

CONSENT AGENDA: Motion by Williams, seconded by Bardsley to approve the consent agenda consisting of minutes of October 14, liquor license for Brothers Market Three, Inc. and list of bills. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Maggie Burger with Speer Financial, Inc. reviewed the city's financial obligations and TIF funds with council.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Williams to approve paying warrants through November 18th, 2024, due to cancellation of the November 11th meeting that falls on Veteran's Day. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Williams to approve Pay Estimate #1 to L.L. Pelling Company, Inc. for 2024 Business 30 Resurfacing in the amount of \$698,490.84. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

The council received the following reports from city departments:

City Engineer Dave Schechinger – water main project is complete, will review again in the spring for any issues, Business 30 resurfacing is complete with minor touch ups, continued work on well #5 feed building.

Public Works Director Travis Bagby – working on leaves, vacuuming will only go as far as the arm reaches to please blow your leaves to the curb, done with millings until spring.

Parks and Recreation Director Drayton Kamberling – Halloweentown will be October 31st from 5-7pm. Girls' basketball started on Sunday.

City Administrator Brandon Siggins – met with SE Linn concerning the community garden, attended Cornell leaders' breakfast, met the new CDG director, worked on transfer agreement and nuisances. The new truck is in service and met with a gentleman concerning new development interests. Will be attending an insurance meeting in Ames next week. Thank you, public works for all your hard work on the alleys, they look amazing.

Council members thanked the public works crews for their hard work on the alleys as well.
