REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
December 9, 2019

CALL TO ORDER: The City Council of Lisbon, Iowa, met in regular session in the City Council Chambers on December 9th, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Beryl O'Connor presiding. The following City Council members were present: John Bardsley, Stephanie Kamberling, Doug O'Connor and Nate Smith. Absent: Travis Jubeck.

Pledge of Allegiance.

Citizen's Present: Sara Nost.

CONSENT AGENDA: Kamberling motioned, seconded by Bardsley to approve the Consent Agenda, consisting of the Agenda, Minutes of November 25, 2019, Approval of Warrants, Treasurer's Report for November 2019 and Liquor License for Gwen's. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Public Input: Meier congratulated Casey and Luke Krall on winning the BE Lisbon Grant. They will receive \$5,000 to help renovate their downtown building where they are planning on opening a photography studio.

Discussion was held once again on the west side door at the History Center. Historic Preservation had asked to hold off on the repairs until the evaluation can be done by Douglas Steinmetz. Eric Yarbrough was concerned with the amount of cold air that is coming in through the door, so council directed public works to see what they can do to insulate the door until the evaluation can be done this month.

Motion by Kamberling, seconded by Smith to approve the quote from Electric Pump to repair the pump at the sewer plant. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Bardsley, seconded by Smith to approve the final payment for the housing rehabilitation in the amount of \$5,888.40. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Smith, seconded by O'Connor to approve the second reading of Ordinance 06-2019. Roll Call: Ayes: Bardsley, Kamberling, O'Connor, Smith. Nays: None. Absent: Jubeck. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Kamberling to reset the public hearing for a possible water and sewer rate increase to December 23, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. Roll Call: Ayes: Bardsley, Kamberling, O'Connor and Smith. Nays: None. Absent: Jubeck. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Kamberling to reset the public hearing for the FY20 Budget Amendment for December 23, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. Roll Call: Ayes: Bardsley, Kamberling, O'Connor and Smith. Nays: None. Absent: Jubeck. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Kamberling to set a public hearing for Gillette Lane Trail Project for December 23, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. Roll Call: Ayes: Bardsley, Kamberling, O'Connor and Smith. Nays: None. Absent: Jubeck. Motion carried 4-0.

Meier asked for all council members to take a look at the CIP materials that were sent in the mail. She asked that they fill out the priority sheet and get it back to her before the next council meeting.

Bagby reported that leaf pick up was complete and they are now working on cleaning out all of the storm drains before it begins to snow. Kamberling asked if there was anything the council could do to make this process easier and Bagby asked that he be able to buy headphones for the guys so they can communicate while they are picking up leaves.

Meier thanked everyone who came to the reception for Mayor O'Connor and reminded everyone of Holiday Jubilee this weekend as well as the open house on January 16th. She also asked for input on removing the tree at Lincoln Park downtown and replacing it with the next tree grant. Council agreed.

O'Connor asked about the gravel that was to be placed by the County on Gillette Road north of Main Street. Bagby stated that they could not get it down due to the early snow fall. He noted that he would check with them again to see what their plan is.

Bardsley reminded everyone of Holiday Jubilee featuring the breakfast at the History Center, a puppet show at 10:00, a holiday movie at 1:00, and a parade at 3:00.

Discussion was held on the lack of a Lisbon sign on the bypass at the Highway 1 exit and also placing a street light at the intersection of Lisbon Blvd. and Business 30. Meier was asked to continue to push for both of these.

Smith thanked Mayor O'Connor for her service.
