February 26th, 2024

The council received the following reports from city departments:

City Engineer Dave Schechinger – Brecke work begins tomorrow on Washington and Main intersection, businesses will remain open during construction.

Public Works Director Travis Bagby – good start on tree trimming, walls are up at the sports pavilion and awaiting utilities, dirt work from plows, seeding window is not open yet, worked on park batting cages.

Parks & Recreation Director Drayton Kamberling – boys' basketball is done, spring soccer registration is open, activity planned for St. Patrick's Day, Easter hunt.

City Administrator Brandon Siggins – March 16th St. Patrick's Day Fireman's dance, Amy White's reception is 6:30-8pm Thursday night, History Center will close during construction due to limited access for handicap, banners for 150th, met with YTT, public works and V&K, and budget work.

Council reminded citizens that dogs need to be restrained to their property and on leashes and complimented the new library director on her first few weeks of transition.
