REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
March 11th, 2024

CALL TO ORDER: The City Council of Lisbon, Iowa, met in regular session on March 11th, 2024, at 7:00p.m. with Mayor Doug O'Connor presiding. The following City Council members were present: John Bardsley, Mike Williams, Rick Scott, Keven Steele and Nathan Smith.

CONSENT AGENDA: Motion by Williams, seconded by Smith to approve the consent agenda consisting of minutes of February 26th, list of bills, utility refunds and February Treasurer's Report. All Ayes. Motion carried 5-0.
