The council received the following reports from city departments:  
City Engineer Dave Schechinger – work on the well project continues.

Public Works Director Travis Bagby – turning on water at parks, plans for painting the pool, complex work. Addressed questions from council concerning sidewalks and grants.

Parks & Recreation Director Drayton Kamberling – mid soccer season, summer sports starting, mowing.

City Administrator Brandon Siggins – St. Patty's Day fundraiser has brought in around \$11,000, working on a fire survey request from the state. Officer Macke graduated the academy, two more officers attending soon, meeting with CDG and a developer for the industrial park, Elite Stone building almost done, nuisances, well 5 site work, sports complex work, N Jackson St. nuisance – going to court in September, new flags going up, insurance went up 13.63%, grass on water main/gas project areas will be sprayed for weeds with continued work for restoration.

Council members congratulated City Clerk Christina Eicher on her new role as Vice President of the Iowa Municipal Finance Officers Association, welcomed the new board member and promoted the numerous events happening at SE Linn.

Mayor Doug O'Connor adjourned the meeting at 7:38pm.
