**REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**  
**August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2025**

**CONSENT AGENDA:** Motion by Bardsley, seconded by Williams to approve the consent agenda consisting of minutes of July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2025, list of bills, utility refunds and July Treasurer's report. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Williams to approve Payment #3 to Linn Haven Land Improvements for Sports Complex Grading. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Bardsley, seconded by Steele to go into public hearing at 7:14pm for Chemical Feed Building and Well No. 5. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

City Engineer Dave Schechinger presented the plans for the chemical building that will also include storage and specs for it to be expandable as needed.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Bardsley to go out of public hearing at 7:17pm. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

City Engineer Dave Schechinger – assisting with Alliant Energy project to ensure ADA compliance on sidewalk replacements, monitoring the Elite Stone project.

Public Works Director Travis Bagby – line painting, Sauerkraut Days preparation, reminder the pool will be closed from Wednesday-Sunday, mowing ditches, lab/DNR issues, brush pickup, and the street sweeper will be out starting tomorrow.

Parks & Recreation Director Drayton Kamberling – scavenger hunt this week for Sauerkraut Days, movie in the park, slow pitch tournament, Fall sports registrations, back to school event on August 20<sup>th</sup>, and the school will be working on a fundraiser for maintenance upgrades to bunting field.

City Administrator Brandon Siggins – fire department is preparing for Sauerkraut Days, washing streets on Wednesday, bathtub races prep. Gravel lot at complex, event preparation, Elite Stone agreement complete, watermain project done, thank you to Public Works for all their in house work and cost savings on that project, SE Linn breakfast was moved to City Hall, thank you to all the volunteers that helped with that event.

The council thanked everyone involved in the 150<sup>th</sup> and Sauerkraut Days activities and Public Works for the water main project work.
