REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
September 22nd, 2025

CALL TO ORDER: The City Council of Lisbon, Iowa, met in regular session on September 22nd, 2025, at 7:00p.m. with Mayor Doug O'Connor presiding. The following City Council members were present: John Bardsley, Rick Scott, Nathan Smith, and Kevin Steele.

OTHERS PRESENT: Brandon Siggins, Travis Bagby, Drayton Kamberling, Jason Blinks, and Dave Schechinger.

CONSENT AGENDA: Motion by Smith, seconded by Bardsley to approve the consent agenda consisting of minutes of September 8th, 2025, and list of bills. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

City Engineer Dave Schechinger reviewed the bids for Well #5 project. Following review with staff, the low bid exceeds the budget, and the scope of work can be modified to achieve significant savings. Motion by Scott, seconded by Smith, to reject all bids received. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Scott to revise the scope of the Well #5 project and go back out for new bids. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Scott, seconded by Smith to approve Downtown Reinvestment Grant Application for Indulgence Salon for new flooring project. All Ayes. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion by Smith, seconded by Bardsley to approve the third and final reading of Ordinance 03-2025 Update to Fireworks. Roll call vote. Ayes: Bardsley, Steele, Smith, and Scott. Absent: None. Nays: None. Motion carried 4-0.

The council received the following reports from city departments:
City Engineer Dave Schechinger – road extension project is going well.

Public Works Director Travis Bagby – installed curb last week, thank you to Drayton and Brian for the extra help, work continues at the complex and Well #5, yard waste/brush date mix up has the public works out cleaning up extra piles.

Parks & Recreation Director Drayton Kamberling – Fall sports underway, girls' basketball registration is open, Halloweentown plans starting and meetings for the sports complex.

Police Chief Jason Blinks – hiring process is underway.

City Administrator Brandon Siggins – Thank you to everyone involved in the work for the Kraiburg road extension, meeting at the sports complex/grading being done, Well #5 in house work, attended the League conference with Christina, working on a nuisance on N Jackson Street and the Alliant project is almost complete.

Mayor and Council congratulated City Clerk Christina Eicher on being named President of the Iowa League of Cities and encouraged residents to check out events happening at the library and heritage hall.
