CITY OF LISBON
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
September 28th, 2023

CALL TO ORDER: The City Council of Lisbon, Iowa, met in special session on September 28th, 2023, at 11:00 a.m. with Mayor Doug O'Connor presiding. The following City Council members were present: John Bardsley and Mike Williams. Rick Scott was present via zoom. Sara Nost and Nathan Smith were absent.

OTHERS PRESENT: Brandon Siggins. Dave Schechinger was present via zoom.

CONSENT AGENDA: Motion by Bardsley, seconded by Williams to approve the agenda. All Ayes. Motion carried 3-0.

City Administrator Brandon Siggins presented the final construction plans for the Lisbon Community School. Additions will be going in on the North and South sides of the school. The North side would have the new addition within five feet of the city water main and the South side would be located on top of the current water main that ties into Highway 30. Planning and Zoning approved the plans with the recommendation of an agreement of understanding concerning the water mains. In a letter sent from the school district, the school has adjusted their plans to move the lines ten feet from the additions prior to or during construction.

Motion by Scott, seconded by Williams to approve the construction plans with the understanding that the school will move the water mains ten feet from the buildings. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Scott, Williams, Bardsley. Nays: None. Absent: Nost, Smith. Motion carried 3-0.
