
Notice All Residents: Water Line Survey

Our water system is conducting a service line inventory. This inventory is being done to comply with EPA regulations and to ensure the safety of our drinking water. We need to know the material composition of the line coming into your house before the meter. Service lines can be made of many materials, such as plastic, copper, PEX HDPE galvanized, and lead. Below are ways you can identify your service line material:

1. If you have had your service line installed or replaced and remember when, and what it is made of you can let us know.
2. If you haven't had a new line installed or do not remember, you can perform visual inspection. This involves inspecting the line where your service line enters your home through the foundation or basement wall before the meter. Plastic (PVC, PEX, HDPE) is easy to identify because most people have had some contact with it in the past. Copper will be green in color if it's been in service for a while. The galvanized appears gray or rusty. Lead appears blue-gray and if you scratch it with a key it will be shiny like a nickel. A magnet will not stick to lead.

Water Billing

Per city policy set by the city council:

- Bills for all residents are sent out on the last business day of each month.
- Billing cycles are the 15th - 15th of the **previous** month
- All bills are **due on the 20th** of each month (*If the 20th falls on a weekend or holiday then the bills will be due the next business day*)
- Any payments **not made by 9am** the day after due date will be sent a late notice letter to the address on the utility account and charged a \$15 fee
- **Seven (7) calendar days** following the late notices, any accounts that have not paid **by 9am** will be considered delinquent and subject to cutoff. At this time a \$50 reconnect fee will be added to the account, if reconnection is requested after 4pm the fee will increase to \$75

The City of Lisbon accepts all forms of payment including:

- Direct pay - payment drafted from a bank account on due day
- Credit cards accepted by phone, in person and online

Payment agreements are available for those needing an extension pending previous payment history. Payment agreements are due by 9am on the 21st prior to late notices being issued.
