

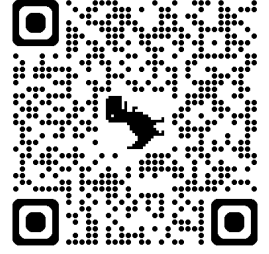

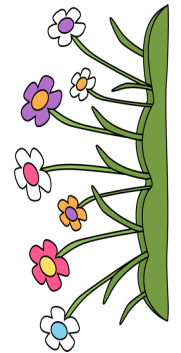

Clean up begins April 1st. Please remove all arrangements you wish to save. Arrangements include all artificial and fresh arrangements on any portion of the lots, slab or monument. This includes flowers in vases attached to the monument and flowers on cradles atop the monument.

New arrangements can be placed after April 15th.

Mt Vernon-Lisbon Police Dept. Reminders:



Per City Code:

- ◆ Lawns should be kept shorter than 8 inches tall, and lawn clippings should not be blown into the street, or into the storm sewers.
- ◆ Lets keep our community clean - Mt Vernon-Lisbon PD will be looking for nuisances properties and junk vehicles.
- ◆ Park vehicles, trailers and campers on hard surfaces only—not on lawns/grass.
- ◆ It’s getting warmer— be diligent, watch for kids on bicycles and kids in and around the schools and the park -especially near the splash-pad.

Outdoor Warning System Sound Refresher

- ◆ A FIRE siren goes up and down for 10 seconds
- ◆ A TORNADO siren goes nonstop, same tone for 3 minutes with voices messages before and after

Lisbon's outdoor system is tested on Saturdays at noon with a message before and after the test.

Residents may also be able to hear sirens:

- 1- City of Mt. Vernon, tested on Wednesday mornings
- 2- Siren at Sutliff, controlled by Johnson County
