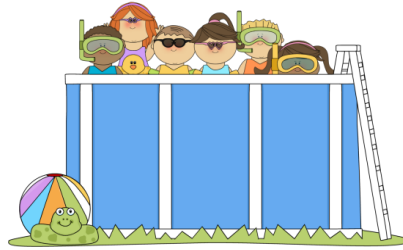

To better manage resources and costs, the City of Lisbon is asking for help from residents and business owners to identify private service line material. Please fill out our short survey to help us complete our inventory in an efficient manner. Pavilion Rentals: Looking for a place to hold your next family gathering, graduation or birthday party? Consider reserving one of the pavilions located at the Lisbon City Park. You can reserve the North and/or South Pavilion with access to picnic tables, kitchenette and refrigerator. You can also reserve Lincoln Square through the city office. Call City Hall today at 319-455-2459 to make your reservation, this gives you priority on usage.

Fire rings must be used for recreational fire use ONLY and must not be more than 3 feet in diameter. Firewood must be good clean wood ONLY. Fires must be located at least 10ft. from any structure. All other fires require a burn permit issued through Linn County.

Golf Cart Permits:

Reminder to stop into City Hall to get your golf cart registered today! \$25.00, proof of insurance and a valid driver's license is all you need to get registered or to renew your application. Questions call 319-455-2459.

Brush pickup will be the 1st MONDAY of every month March through November. Small sticks, twigs and branches need to be placed in neat piles on the curb to be chipped. This is performed by Lisbon Public Works Dept.

Yard Waste pickup will be the 2nd MONDAY of every month March through November. Garden debris needs to be placed in a rigid container or a yard waste bag for easy pick up. This is performed by Johnson County Refuse.

Appliances limited to 2 per household or business and tanning beds go to the city shop with the bulbs removed. Any small motorized equipment brought in needs to be drained of gas and oil.

ELECTRONICS DROP OFF – CITY HALL PARKING LOT

Vehicles should enter from Washington St and exit via alley.

RESTRICTIONS: Businesses limited to 2 items for drop off, batteries of any kind are NOT accepted.

NO HAZARDOUS ITEMS–

Must be taken to Linn County Landfill, Marion

Outdated prescriptions/meds – Drug box located outside

City Hall's front door, NO SHARPS.

Proper disposal of flags—drop box @ City Hall

NOT ACCEPTED: Any material usually deposited in garbage bags, construction material (shingles, concrete, re-rod, etc.), burn barrels and ash, and large commercial appliances.

ok to sell fireworks in city limits with a permit issued through the city
offices. **IT IS NOT OK FOR ANYONE TO LIGHT FIREWORKS
WITHIN CITY LIMITS. Per code...**“It shall be unlawful for any
person, or entity, to use or explode any fireworks within the City lim-
its.” Fireworks displays are approved by council and given a permit.
