Pool Filling: Reminder to call City Hall prior to filling your personal pool for the first time. The City allows for a one time reduction each year on filling personal pools over 1,000 gallons. Please call City Hall in order to receive this reduction 319-455-2459.

Pavilion Rentals: Looking for a place to hold your next family gathering, graduation or birthday party? Consider reserving one of the pavilions located at the Lisbon City Park. You can reserve the North and/or South Pavilion with access to picnic tables, kitchenette and refrigerator. You can also reserve the small open air pavilion at the park or Lincoln Square. Call City Hall today at 319-455-2459 to make your reservation.

Fire rings must be used for recreational fire use ONLY and must not be more than 3 feet in diameter. Firewood must be good clean wood ONLY. Fires must be located at least 10 feet from any structure. All other fires require a burn permit issued through Linn County.

Golf Cart Permits:

Reminder to stop into City Hall to get your golf cart registered today! \$25.00, proof of insurance and a valid driver's license is all you need to get registered or to renew your application. Questions call 319-455-2459.

Brush pickup will be the **1st WEEK** of every month March through November. Small sticks, twigs and branches need to be placed in neat piles on the curb to be chipped. This is performed by Lisbon Public Works Department.

Yard Waste pickup will be the **2nd MONDAY** of every month March through November. Garden debris needs to be placed in a rigid container or a yard waste bag for easy pick up. This work is completed by Johnson County Refuse.

LARGE ITEM DROP OFF @ CITY SHOP

Vehicles should approach area going East on Market St to City Shop.
RESTRICTIONS: NO TIRES OR TREES WILL BE ACCEPTED!
Appliances limited to 2 per household or business and tanning beds go to the city shop with the bulbs removed. Any small motorized equipment brought in needs to be drained of gas and oil.

ELECTRONICS DROP OFF @ CITY HALL PARKING LOT

Vehicles should enter from Washington St and exit via alley.
RESTRICTIONS: Businesses limited to 2 items for drop off, batteries of any kind are NOT accepted.

NO HAZARDOUS ITEMS!

Must be taken to Linn County Landfill, Marion

Outdated prescriptions/meds – Drug box located inside City Hall's front door, NO SHARPS.
Proper disposal of flags - drop box at City Hall.

NOT ACCEPTED:

Any material usually deposited in regular garbage pickup, construction materials (shingles, concrete, re-rod, etc.), burn barrels, ash, large commercial appliances, tires, batteries, or hazardous materials.

The City and Johnson County Refuse reserve the right to refuse any items on the day of drop off.

Please avoid using staples, paper clips, rubber bands as they can corrode over time and leave residue on other contents.
