Information regarding Snow Removal

Snow Emergency Declared - Parking on streets on the Snow Routes is **prohibited** during a declared Snow Emergency from the time it goes into effect until snow removal operations have been completed.

STREETS—The City is divided into 4 quadrants, 1 truck per quadrant. After the snow session has ended, all quadrants will be clean at the same time and backed up to the curb. We would like to remind residents of our ordinance on NOT placing snow from your property in the street.

SIDEWALKS- Residents must remove snow and ice on sidewalks within twenty-four (24) hours after a measurable snowfall. In the case of ice where removal is not possible, sand or other covering must be placed.

Snow or ice NOT removed in a timely manner will be removed by city employees and the property owner will be billed for all expenses.

Dumping of Snow - Snow or ice thrown, pushed or placed into the traveled portion of a street or alley so as to obstruct gutters or impede the passage of vehicles upon the street or alley or to create a hazardous condition, is unlawful and will be removed at the property owner's expense.
